Students are welcome to enroll in more than 2 academic courses and may be encouraged to do so in a separate communication.

# 2021 SUMMER SCHOOL OFFERINGS

(Grades listed represent the grade they *will be entering* in fall 2021)

## **BAND LESSONS – Grade 6**

Are you going into 6th grade and plan on taking band? This is the course for you! Experiment with different instruments and find your perfect match. Already have an instrument in mind? Great! We will get you started on all of the skills we will be using in 6th grade band class. This will be a fun course targeted towards preparing you to play with a full band. This is 100% recommended if you are even thinking about being in band!

## **BAND BASICS – Grades 7-8**

If you are an incoming 7th or 8th grade band student who is having a bit of a struggle with your instrument, please join this course! We will be going back to basics to get to the bottom of the struggle and work as a group to help each other out. This is also a great course for you if you are wanting to switch instruments or learn another. Taking the initiative to join this course is the hardest part! Start improving your instrument skills and make band more fun!

## **BAND JAM – Grades 7-8**

If you are in 7th and 8th grade band and love making music with your friends, join in on this course! This will be 100% devoted to playing fun and current music as a group. ## **PEP BAND PREP – Grades 9-12**

## **BOOKS COME TO LIFE – Grade 5K**

Come join as we take a familiar story & bring it to life through acting & re-telling! You will have the materials to leave & give your own story performance to others!

## **BOWLING – Grades 2-9**

Join us at Oconto Lanes to learn a new pastime or brush up on your bowling skills.

## **CASTLES, KNIGHTS AND DRAGONS – Grades 3-9**

Do you like outdoor games like tag? How about a game of tag with swords!? Learn about medieval times while designing castles, your own coat of arms, and a foam sword! Take your sword onto the battlefield with friends and engage in an epic game of live action role playing. (Larp) Reenact historic war strategies like the viking shield wall, or the roman testudo formation. Elect, and then protect, your king and queen from opposing teams! Finally, fend for yourself in a competition of solo duels to find out which student is the last knight standing and is crowned this year's champion!

## **CERAMICS, CLAY, and COIL POTS! – Grades 3-9**

How would you like to eat your cereal from a bowl you made yourself?! Or sip your favorite drink from a cup you designed and created? Maybe you want a plate with its own special dipping sauce holder? Or perhaps your grandma needs a new vase for her flowers? In this class we'll learn about the proper techniques to form clay into various dishes you can use at home! We'll even paint our projects with food-safe glazes so you can put your dish in the dishwasher when you're done using it!

## **CHECK OUT THE OCONTO LIBRARY! – Grades K-4**

Explore the world of literacy through STEM activities, games, scavenger hunts and crafts while making and writing your own book.

### **DANCING ARTS OF INDIA – Grades 4-9**

Kathak is a storytelling classical dance form of India known for fast footwork, spins, delicate gestures and facial expressions. It's very rhythmic and similar to Ballet and tap dance.

### **DNR ATV/UTV SAFETY COURSE – Grades 7-9**

A course on safe and responsible off-road vehicle operation. This class will include information on the safe operation of ATVs and UTVs, provide general information on survival skills and summarize ATV and UTV regulations.

### **DNR BOAT SAFETY COURSE – Grades 7-9**

A course on responsible boating which includes general information concerning boats and maintenance, information to make your boating experience safer and more comfortable, tips on how to be a more courteous boat operator and laws and regulations to which you must adhere.

### **DODGEBALL – Grades 3-5**

Use teamwork and strategy to play several different variations of dodgeball games.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE - INTERRELATIONS – Grades 5-8**

Students develop skills to identify components of the natural environment and investigate relationships between organisms.

### **FISHING FRENZY – Grades 3-9**

Are you an angler? Do you want to learn how to catch more fish? Come outdoors and join us for a fishing adventure! Learn how to tie proper fishing knots. Learn what color lures work best in different weather and water conditions. Learn to bait your own hook, cast into the distance, and even know the different types of fish in our area! This is a catch and release fishing class where all the gear needed to land that big one is provided for you! Hope to see you there!

### **HEALTHY BODIES, HEALTHY MINDS – Grades 1-3**

"Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds: A Mindful Approach to Emotions, Nutrition, and Movement"

Exploring interests and emotions through UW- Extension 4-H Cloverbud and FoodWise Activities in this course your child will participate in a variety of activities to help them discover what makes them unique. We all have areas of interest, and experience emotions as we go through life that shapes who we are. Your child will get to explore and wonder using all of their senses to learn and grow while gaining valuable skills including: goal setting, teamwork, time and stress management, self regulation, reflection, health and nutrition. They will get to experience new things and decide which of them spark excitement and joy for them. Activities will be facilitated by the UW-Madison, Division of Extension 4-H Program and Foodwise Educators for Oconto and Marinette Counties. Planned activities will follow the experiential learning model- DO- REFLECT-APPLY, and have been developed by state and national accredited resources. Your child does not need to be a current 4-H member to participate, but will have an opportunity to join if you decide to. Packets with learning materials and supplies will be distributed to each participant.

### **HISTORY OF AMERICAN FOOTBALL – Grades 6-8 & 9-12**

Do you enjoy watching & learning about the game of football? In this course we will be learning about the history of football from the beginning to modern times! We will discuss important people & events who have played a role in the game of football. We will also be outside simulating how football has changed over time with rules, regulations, and formations!

### **HOURLY OF CODE – Grades 6-8**

Students will use web based learning tools to understand the basics of coding. Students will create things like games and websites using the concepts learned in class

### **INTRODUCTION TO COOKIE AND CAKE DECORATING – Grades 5-8**

Students will learn the basics of cake and cookie decorating.

### **KICK BACK AND READ– Grades 6-8**

There are too many great books to read and not enough time! Students in this class will have time to share, discuss, and read books in a relaxing environment. Feel free to show up empty-handed or with a pile of great books to read.



### **MINECRAFT MADNESS– Grades 3-9**

Whether you're a Minecraft master, or have never played before, this class is an adventure waiting for you! Work together with classmates and your teacher to build a community! Design buildings, establish trade, and farm animals and crops. Learn how to use redstone for basic electrical connections. Learn how to forge tools and armor before adventuring together through mountains, caves, and oceans! Protect each other, create stories, and discover a world of imagination! Come join us!

### **MUSIC THROUGH THE DECADES– Grades 8-12**

Do you enjoy music? We will be looking at the most popular songs from the 1960s-2000 and seeing how music has changed over time. We will be looking at how music has changed over the decades and what genres of music have survived over the years.

### **ORDER IN THE COURT: MOCK TRIAL WORKSHOP– Grades 5-8**

Take on the role of lawyers, jurors, and witnesses to enact fictitious trials while learning the basics of courtroom procedure, advocacy, negotiation and public speaking

### **PICKLEBALL 101 – Grades 6-8 & 9-12**

Are you interested in learning the fastest growing sport in America!? We will focus on skills and drills on how to become a proficient pickleball player. It's a fun and exciting sport, you might even become addicted!

### **PUZZLEPALOOZA– Grades 1-8**

Puzzlers! Take the challenge! Can your team win the honor of fastest Puzzle Champs? Teams of two to four people will compete to finish a 1,000 piece puzzle in the shortest amount of time!

### **REMEDIAL MATH – Grades K-4**

Students will build math skills using research-based strategies based on Math Recovery. Using AVMR assessments, these sessions will target specific foundational skills that are impeding their understanding and progress in Math. Students will then systematically build number sense through the use of activities/strategies that will improve: structuring numbers (combining and partitioning numbers without counting by 1s), counting and advanced counting as well as addition and subtraction skills.

### **ROCK PAINTING OF OCONTO – Grades 1-8**

Do you like to paint? Have you ever found a painted rock while out on an adventure? Join the Rock Painting of Oconto group to show off your painting skills. At the end of the class, we will venture through Oconto and hide our rocks in different places for others to find.

### **RUNNING CLUB – Grades 5-8**

Do you like to run? Running club allows for a fun hour filled with running, relays, and fun! Come dressed in gym clothes and running shoes! A water bottle is recommended!

### **SMARTBOARD GAMES GALORE – Grades 5K**

We will take our favorite smartboard games like abcya.com & FunBrainJr.com & explore how to play them as a group. You will also be given time to play them by yourself or with a partner. Come play with us!

### **SO YOU THINK YOU CAN DANCE AND SING? - Grades 3-6**

Put on your dancing shoes, warm up your vocal chords, and join the fun!! This course will make you feel like a star. We will review basic dance steps and you will be the choreographer. You will choreograph a variety of dances to some of the hottest music of the past and present. You will also have an opportunity to showcase your talent singing karaoke to the pop hits of today. There will be a performance of your talents on the last day of the program.

### **SPRING AROUND THE WORLD – Grade 5K**

Have you ever seen the Great Wall of China? Do you know what country takes the longest time to cross? Or where you can go and see 18 of the worlds 22 most deadliest snakes? Get your passport ready and be ready to intake on adventures that you would not see in Oconto!

### **STORY PLAY – Grades 2-5**

Everyone loves story time! In this class we take our favorite stories, and act them out! We will play games and create "mess-up" stories and bring our own stories to life!

### **STEM Rube Goldberg – Grades 6-8**

Students will work with simple machines and concepts related to physics as they work in teams to plan build, and improve designs to pop a balloon and trap a mouse.

### **SWIMMING LESSONS– Grades K-8**

Swimming lessons allow kids the opportunity to be safe in and around water. Learn to swim classes are taught by knowledgeable and caring instructors at the Bond Community Center, who can help swimmers feel comfortable in the water and progress to the next level. Join us for learning and fun!

### **TEACHING ASSISTANT– Grades 9-12**

Are you a high school student interested in a future career working with children? If so, join us this summer to assist the teachers and gain valuable experience in curriculum planning, classroom management, student interaction and so much more! **Upon successful completion of this course students will earn 0.5 high school credit.**

### **TEAM SPORTS Grades 1-4 & 5-8**

We will play kickball, basketball, baseball and other team sports. We will play a variety of games that encourage teamwork, good sportsmanship, and strategizing.

### **VOLLEYBALL FUN– Grades 3-5**

Skill development: serving, passing, setting and hitting. Fun games too!

### **VOLLEYBALL FUN II– Grades 6-8**

Intermediate Skill development: serving, passing, setting and hitting. Fun games too!

### **Wiffle Ball– Grades K-12**

Students will begin by learning the fundamentals of crime scene investigation. The mock crime scene will replicate real life police response, from the dispatch of the call to the case being solved. Students have an exciting opportunity to explore the law enforcement career!

Designed to improve athletes strength, power and speed. 3 sessions held daily, students can choose from above time options.

All school rules and regulations will apply during summer school.

**To help ensure students transition into their summer school routine as smoothly as possible it is imperative that families are proactive in determining transportation (drop off and pick up) plans for their children and that those plans are communicated with each child.**

Any students not utilizing the city or rural bus transportation provided by the district should report to the building location of their earliest course.

(OES = Oconto Elementary School, OMS = Oconto Middle School, BOND = Bond Community Center, Bowling = Oconto Lanes)

**Students may be picked up at the location of their final course or at Oconto Elementary School.**

## Summer School Bus Example

John has the following schedule:

<u>Time</u>	<u>Course</u>	<u>Building</u>
Period 1	3rd Grade Reading	OES
Period 2	Bowling	Bowling Alley
Period 3	Swimming	BOND CENTER
Period 4	STEM	OMS
Period 5	Story Play	OMS

John should be dropped at OES by his parents at 8:00 AM. When Period 1 ends, John will take the bus to the Bowling Alley. When Period 2 ends, John will take the bus to the Bond Center. For Period 4 the bus will take John to the middle school for STEM and Story Play. At 3:00 PM, John can be picked up at OMS or take the bus back to OES to be picked up at the Elementary School.

## Summer School Course Registration Instructions

To register your student(s) for Summer School please follow the below instructions. Please note if you do not have a parent portal account or are having trouble logging into the system please email [help@oconto.k12.wi.us](mailto:help@oconto.k12.wi.us) and they will provide you with your login information.

1. Go to the parent portal website. <https://wicloud2.infinitecampus.org/campus/portal/oconto.jsp>.
2. Choose Campus Parent and enter your username and password.
3. Once you are logged in you will go to the MORE option in the left hand menu.
4. Then Choose Course Registration and choose the summer school option.
5. If you have multiple children be sure you have selected the correct student you wish to enroll in summer school. You will notice the student you are on by the picture of the student in the upper right hand corner. If this is not the correct student you can click on the drop down arrow by the students picture in the upper right corner and switch to the correct student.
6. Next select the blue Add Course option and click the plus symbol to add the course your student wants. Once you click the plus symbol you will have 2 options Request and Alternative. You should choose the Request option and NOT Alternative.
7. Please note that Academic courses can be identified by (ACA) at the end of the course title. As previously mentioned it is **highly recommended**, but not required, that each student **enroll in a minimum of 2 academic courses**, and 3 enrichment. Students are welcome to enroll in more than 2 academic courses.
8. Repeat this step for all the courses your student would like to take for summer school. You can select up to 5 courses. Be sure you are choosing a Request option and Not Alternative for each course.
9. Now you need to select 2 Alternative courses. If for some reason a course does not run or has a scheduling conflict your student will be placed into one of the Alternative classes so be sure your Alternative classes are something your student is interested in.
