As coronavirus (COVID-19) continues to spread, we want to reassure you that protecting the health and safety of both students and staff is our priority. We are continuing to monitor COVID-19 closely. You may be already aware, however, we wanted to share with you the <u>order for statewide school closure</u> announced by Governor Evers.

OUSD will follow the order by Governor Evers as stated, "As ordered the closure of all public and private Wisconsin schools for purposes of pupil instruction and extracurricular activities, beginning Wednesday, March 18, 2020, with an anticipated reopening on April 6, 2020. The date of reopening is subject to change pending further information."

We will be able to hold athletics and club activities on Monday and Tuesday of next week. However, starting on Wednesday, March 18, 2020 all athletics, and club activities will be cancelled until returning on April 6, 2020.

As we continue to monitor this situation, please know that the administration will convene to develop a plan for days that are missed. Such plans could include virtual instruction or extending our school year. All information will be shared with you via email and social media as soon as a plan is developed.

We at OUSD will do our best to keep you informed and partner with you to protect the well-being of our students, staff, and families.
